COMPLIANCE

The introduction of the Work Health and Safety Act of 2011 attempts to establish a range of duties to ensure compliance. The duties and obligations apply to persons conducting a business or undertaking (PCBU) or as a worker. Regardless of whether you, your workplace or the Body Corporate you manage, are considered a PCBU, there is a responsibility to manage exposure to risk.

Here is a simple checklist......

DUE DILIGENCE

- Keep up to date on health and safety matters
- Understand the operations in running a body corporate and the hazards and risks
- associated
- Take an interest in the resources, processes and systems in place to manage hazards and risks
- Ensure that persons responsible for managing exposure to risk apply processes and systems

DUTY OF CARE

- Duty of care to exercise reasonable instruction, policies or procedures
- Duty of care to ensure the health and safety of any persons accessing Body Corporate common property.

STANDARDS

 Use relevant codes of practice, building codes and Australian standards as a benchmark to manage exposure to risk.

Annual Safety Compliance audits (Highly recommended)

- Reduces exposure to risks resulting in less chance of the Body Corporate facing litigation
- A safety audit is an unofficial insurance policy confirming the Body Corporate has taken proactive measures to manage exposure to risk
- The Body Corporate which complies with relevant Acts and Legislation may be covered in the event of an accident/incident.
- Maintain an up to date level of knowledge regarding the Legislation ensuring you are familiar with new Standards as they are introduced
- Assurance that the common property has been risk assessed
- Consultation with a WH&S Inspector to discuss any concerns relating to the health and safety of the common property.
